It's easier than you may think

Redwood Glen offers information on a variety of ways to make your commitment:

- **Retirement Plans:** Designate Redwood Glen to receive part or all of what remains of your retirement plan after your death. Such transfers can be a very tax-efficient way of making a gift. For example, heirs may receive as little as 30% of a retirement plan from a large estate after estate tax and income tax. Redwood Glen will receive all of it tax-free.
- **Insurance policies:** Designate Redwood Glen to receive all or part of the proceeds of a life insurance policy. Ask your insurance company for a beneficiary designation form.
- **A Charitable Bequest:** Instruct your attorney to add a charitable bequest for Redwood Glen to your estate plan for a specific amount, a specific property, or for a percentage of the estate.
